Cost: \$25 (includes completion certificate, Oak Leaf patch and BBQ lunch)

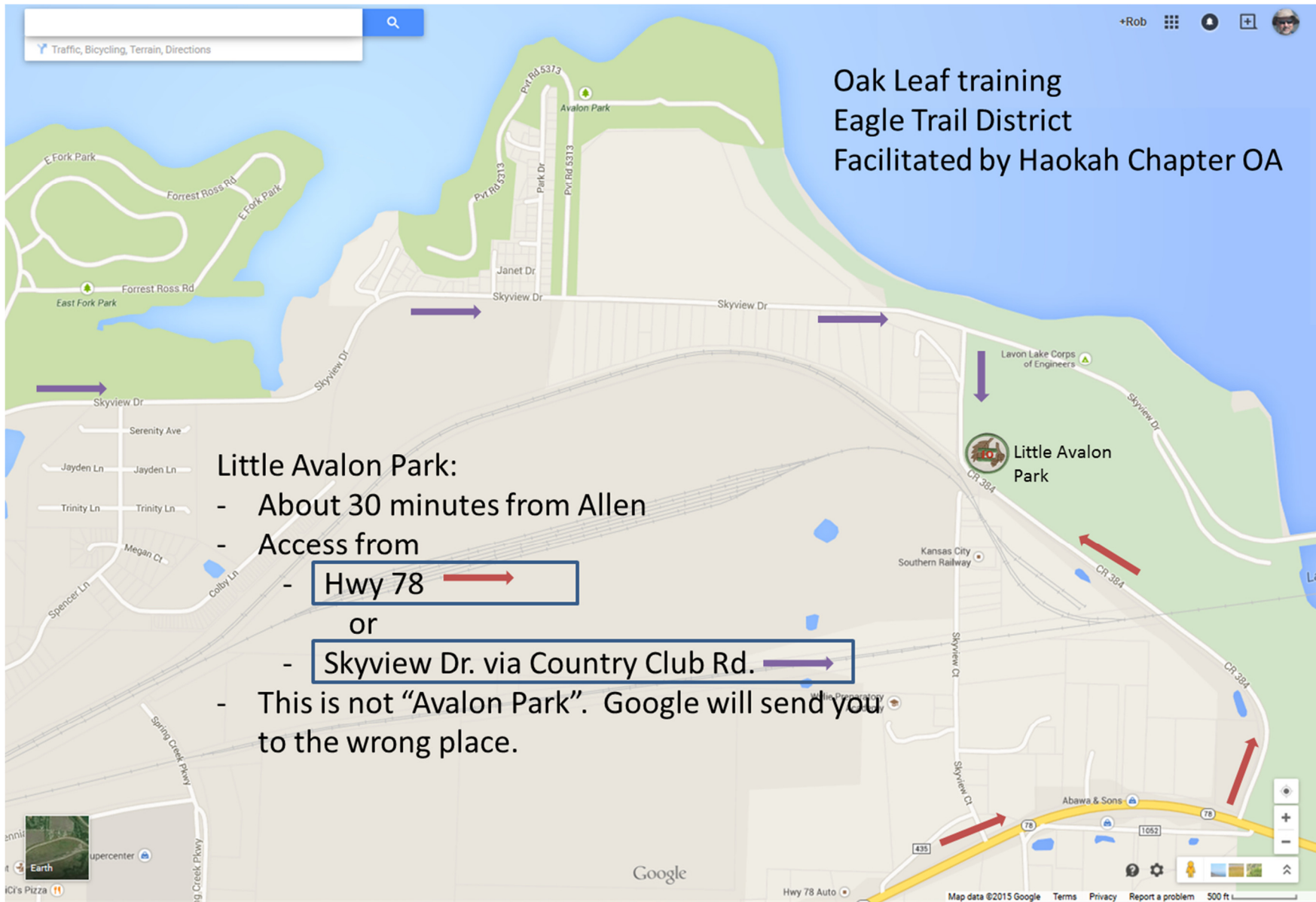
